

# 2010 CAMP KERR LAKE GENERAL INFORMATION

We are excited to be opening the Camp for the 2010 season, and would like to remind you of some new spiritual activities we've added to our regular weekly schedule. Each morning at 9:00am we'll be offering **"Our Daily Bread and Coffee"** devotional time in the Welcome Center, a short half-hour time of worship, Bible study, and fellowship to help you get your day moving in the right direction. On Tuesday and Thursday mornings at 10:00am we'll be hosting a **"Walk in the Spirit" hike** on one of our new nature trails. On Thursday evenings at 7:00pm we'll **"Dive In" the Word**, a one-hour, verse-by-verse Bible study at the Welcome Center. On Sunday mornings, we'll begin our worship together at 10:00am in the Picnic Pavilion, and at 7:00pm on Sunday evenings we'll be having a **"Welcoming Dessert and Worship Celebration"**. We're looking forward to seeing each of you at one or more of these great spiritual opportunities.

We will be open during **weekends only from April 30 through May 21, 2010**. We will be open **full time from May 28 through September 26, 2010**. It is our goal to provide you, our guests, with a clean, safe, peaceful, and spiritually encouraging camping environment. The following information is provided to help you plan your valuable vacation time, and to allow us to respond as effectively as possible in meeting your needs.

## Reservations

**We are a reservation-only operation, with a 2-night minimum, and do not accept drop-ins. Beginning January 1, 2010** reservations will be accepted by mail. After March 1, 2010 reservations can also be accepted by phone or made in person at the Camp, however, **reservation of sites and dates are assigned upon receipt of the required deposit and a completed reservation form**. As usual, priority will be given to those guests requesting reservations for 7 nights or more. If the site(s) requested is/are not available, a second or third choice site will be reserved if available. Unfortunately, we are **not able to accept credit/debit cards**, but personal checks are always welcome.

The following additional restrictions apply:

- **Minimum of two nights stay** for all reservations
- **Memorial Day weekend** and **Labor Day weekend** require a minimum 3-night stay.
- **Fourth of July week** requires a minimum 7-night stay.
- **Maximum stay is 14 days**

## Deposit

A **\$50.00** deposit is required for **each date and site** you wish to reserve.

## Confirmation

A confirmation of your reservation will be mailed, emailed or made by phone as soon as your application and deposit have been processed. We'll begin making confirmation notifications in February.

## Full Payments

In order to guarantee your site, **full payment (less deposit) is due two weeks prior to arrival** at Camp. A payment reminder will accompany your confirmation letter, email, or phone call.

## Cancellations and Refunds

**Full payments will be refunded if you cancel your reservation more than two (2) weeks before the initial date reserved.** For cancellations after that date, we will make every effort to rent your site or facility for the period you reserved, and will refund that portion of fees paid only if rented. Cancellations and requests for refunds may be made to the Camp Registrar by any of the means provided above.

## R.V. Storage

Recreational Vehicles (i.e. motor homes, travel trailers, pop-up campers, etc. and/or trailered boats and boat trailers) may be stored on the camp grounds (in the area designated) provided the equipment is to be used in relation to a fee paying, camp visit within the next 4 weeks. The minimum storage fee charge is for one week and is charged for any partial week. Storage of any RV('s) **must not** be initiated until a "**Liability Release Form**" has been executed by the owner and witnessed by the Camp Manager.

## Check-in & Check-out

**Check-in is at 4:00 PM.** Early check-in after 12:00 noon is permitted if the site is not occupied. Check-in **prior to noon** is permitted if site is not occupied for an additional fee of \$5.00. **Check-out is at 2:00 PM.** Late check-out until 6:00 PM is permitted if the site is available and **only with the prior permission of the camp manager.**

## Liability Disclaimer

Individuals, families and/or groups engaging in any recreational activities on the property do so **at their own risk.** This includes all swimming and/or other water activities conducted in and/or on Kerr Lake Reservoir. **No lifeguards are provided.** Children must be supervised by adults, and adults must not swim alone.

**Resident Manager** is at the camp full-time during the camping season when campers are onsite. The resident manager is responsible for supervising and maintaining the camp facilities, checking guests in and out, and overseeing programs and services provided by the camp.

## Accommodations:

**RV Hook-Up Sites:** There are 26 sites, equipped with electrical and water connections overlooking the lake. There are two bathhouses with hot showers and a large, grassy recreation field that can be used for play and sport activities.

**A-Frame Cabins:** Each of our 6 rustic cabins have eight bunks with mattresses (8 people maximum) in a secluded wooded area. There is a picnic shelter with 8 picnic tables and a commercial gas grill centrally located to the cabins, and a private swim area located down a short path to the waterfront. The bathhouse is located only a short walking distance away via a path through the woods. Porta-potties are available in the A-Frame area May-September.

**Pavilion, Hospitality Room, Recreation Area:** These are available for rent for half-day or full-day events. There is a bathhouse with hot showers, a boat ramp, a swimming area, picnic tables, a volleyball court, a basketball goal, a play structure and lots of room for field games. The Hospitality Room is located in the Welcome Center, is air-conditioned, and will seat approximately 30 people (theater-style) or 20 people at tables. **Free wireless (Wi-Fi) internet access** is available in the Hospitality Room for our guests.

**Constraints:** It is our policy not to permit overnight lodging by any unmarried couples in the same RV, tent, or cabin, as it is clearly inconsistent with scriptural principles regarding the sanctity of marriage in God's Word, the Bible, and our ministry's Statement of Faith. It is also our policy not to permit the use of any of our facilities to those who choose not to abide by our Camp Kerr Lake Community Covenants.

**Pedal Boats, Canoes, and Sailboats:** Pedal boats, canoes, and sailboats are available for rent.

**Garbage and Trash Disposal** is provided only from trash receptacles stationed near each site.

**Sewage Dump Station** at the west bathhouse is available for RV's with holding tanks.
